## (1:40) Feedback to Oregon Legislature People of Color Caucus

Bill reported that the Leadership Council met with Senator Lew Frederick to look into ongoing communication for the OSMBCC and the Oregon legislature POC

- Meeting with Oregon Legislator People of Color Caucus
  - OSMBCC Leadership Council to meet with Oregon Legislature POC throughout the year
- List of legislative requests from us to Sen. Lew Frederick
  - Push forward to add the racial impact as a part of all bills, i.e. similar to the current process done for environmental and funding impacts

- Apply equity lens and racial equity lens to law making
- Require mandatory reporting for racial and hate speeches and abuse toward minors in all school activities
- Compensation for school board members

Jessica shared that Representative Teresa Alonso León reached out to her for legislative concepts as well. She is the lead of Education Committee.

Designate a Leadership Council member as the point person to lead the legislative work similar to how Erika is serving as the editor of the newsletter. Would the vice president be good to have this in his/her portfolio? All agreed that is a good idea.

Linda motioned to have Sami be the lead to work with the legislature until the next election when the new vice president is elected. Sonja seconded. Unanimous. MC.
